SEARCH AND SEIZURE WARRANT

I find that the affidavit(s), or any recorded testimony, establish probable cause to search and seize the person or property.
YOU ARE COMMANDED to execute this warrant on or before 5-9-2011 (not to exceed 14 days)

In the daytime 6:00 a.m. to 10 p.m. at any time in the day or night as I find reasonable cause has been established.

Unless delayed notice is authorized below, you must give a copy of the warrant to the person from whom, or from whose premises, the property was taken, and to the person at the place where the property was taken.

The officer executing this warrant, or an agent of the U.S. Marshals Service, must prepare an inventory as required by law and present it to the United States Magistrate Judge.

Obtain or make copies of the "STOP" side of this flier and loosely scotch tape the copy to the "inside" part [not outside part] of your front and back doors, so, you can quickly grab this sheet if a law enforcement official knocks on your apartment's, house's, or non-public work site's entry door.

Slide the sheet under your door or hold it up to a nearby window so you can tell the officer that you **do not consent to their search unless** they show you a valid judicial search warrant with a judge's signature. Use this sheet to also inform the officer that you wish to remain silent and that you want an attorney present if you are being questioned...
